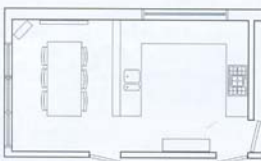

her own. Again, there's both a practical and an aesthetic reason. "The items that are on display are the things I use all the time; it's a really ergonomic kitchen, but also I didn't want a room full of boxes. Having cupboards everywhere would have felt too dominant," Liz explains.

"Creating a stylish look doesn't necessarily mean spending a lot of money – the metal unit

is from Habitat – it's more about having an eye for what works," she reflects. Round the oak dining table, for example, she chose three different sets of chairs – two oak, two black, and two black and white. "I like that mismatched style, just mixing things up," she says. And as this kitchen demonstrates perfectly, sometimes simple really is best.
